What is Lighthouse Summer Camp?

This is a chance for young people aged 11-17 to get together, have fun, develop new skills, make new friends and explore the Christian faith. Activities include rock climbing, swimming, sports, crafts and a day trip. We explore a theme together during the week and worship in creative ways. The theme this year is Temptation.

When will it happen? Saturday 4th to Saturday 11th August 2018

Where will it happen? Honeyhill Campsite, Thurnham Lane, Bearsted, Maidstone, Kent ME14 4PW, UK

How much will it cost and what is included? The cost of the camp is £100 per person for the whole week. Tents, meals, and activities equipment will be provided.

What will the young people need to bring with them?

A sleeping bag and pillow, suitable clothing & footwear, toiletries & towel, torch, bible, notepad and pen etc. A detailed kit list will be provided to all those who book. There will also be a tuck shop and a day out so a small amount of pocket money to spend on both things is an option.

Who is organising it?

It is being organised by a team of volunteers led by Tom Hackett (Children and Youth Development Officer for Southern Synod.)

How do I know that it will be run safely?

The camp will be run in accordance with the United Reformed Church good practice guidelines for safeguarding children & young people. All leaders undergo a careful appointment process (including a check for criminal records) and are expected to attend a training day before camp. Specialised outdoor activities such as rock climbing will be fully supervised by properly qualified instructors. For transport to off-site activities, the minibus drivers will hold a valid MIDAS minibus driving certificate. There will be qualified first aiders at the event.

How to book?

Complete and return the booking form and a non-returnable deposit of £25 (cheques are payable to 'URC Southern Synod Trust Ltd') before 31st May 2018. After the booking form has been received, you will be sent more details together with a consent form & a medical form which will need to be completed and returned before the camp.
